KWS Cochise is the highest yielding spring breadmaking wheat on the 2022/23 Recommended List. It performs well both spring and late autumn-sown where it yields 10% and 6% ahead of Mulika, respectively.

A high performing spring wheat, Cochise has good grain quality, including an outstanding specific weight of 78.5kg/hl and good protein content to serve milling contracts (13.2%).

In the field, the variety is tall but stiff-strawed with a solid disease profile, including the added benefits of OWBM resistance and resistance to Soil Borne Wheat Mosaic Virus.

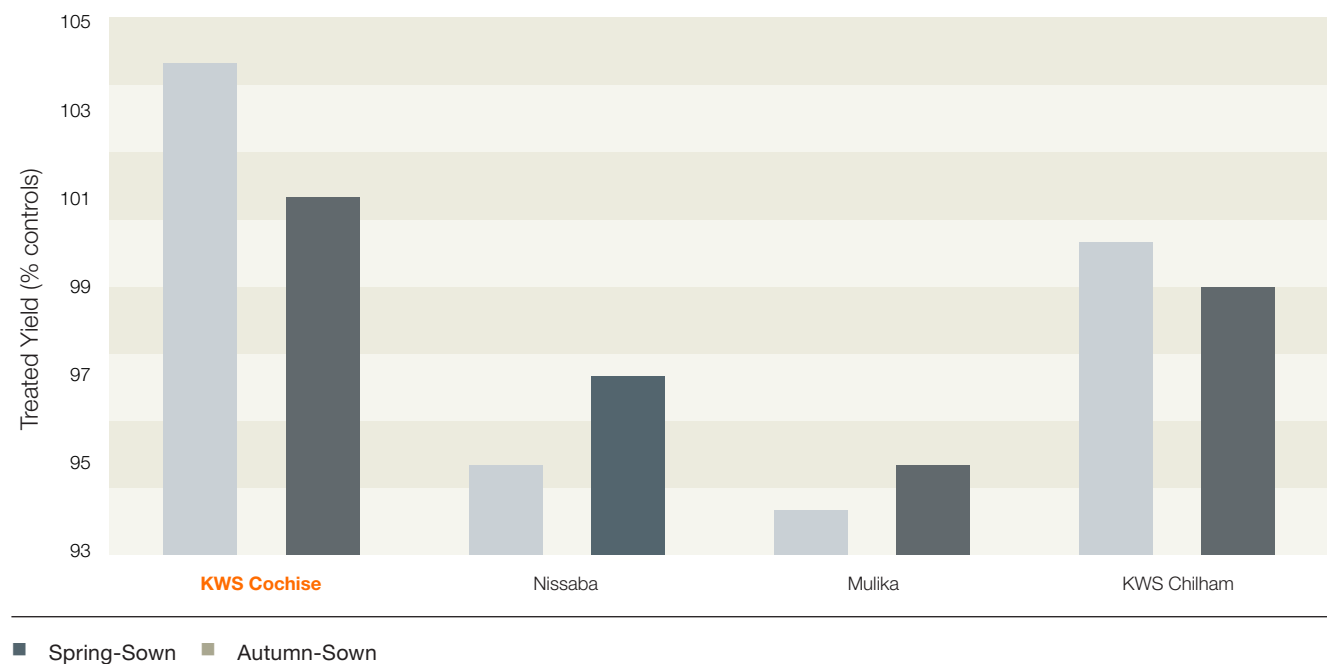

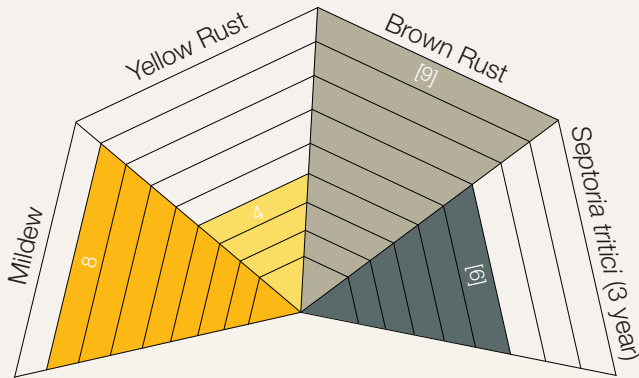
